Arctic terns migrate over 40,000 kilometres from their Arctic breeding grounds to Antarctica.

Look out for aquatic birds that appear to have only one leg!

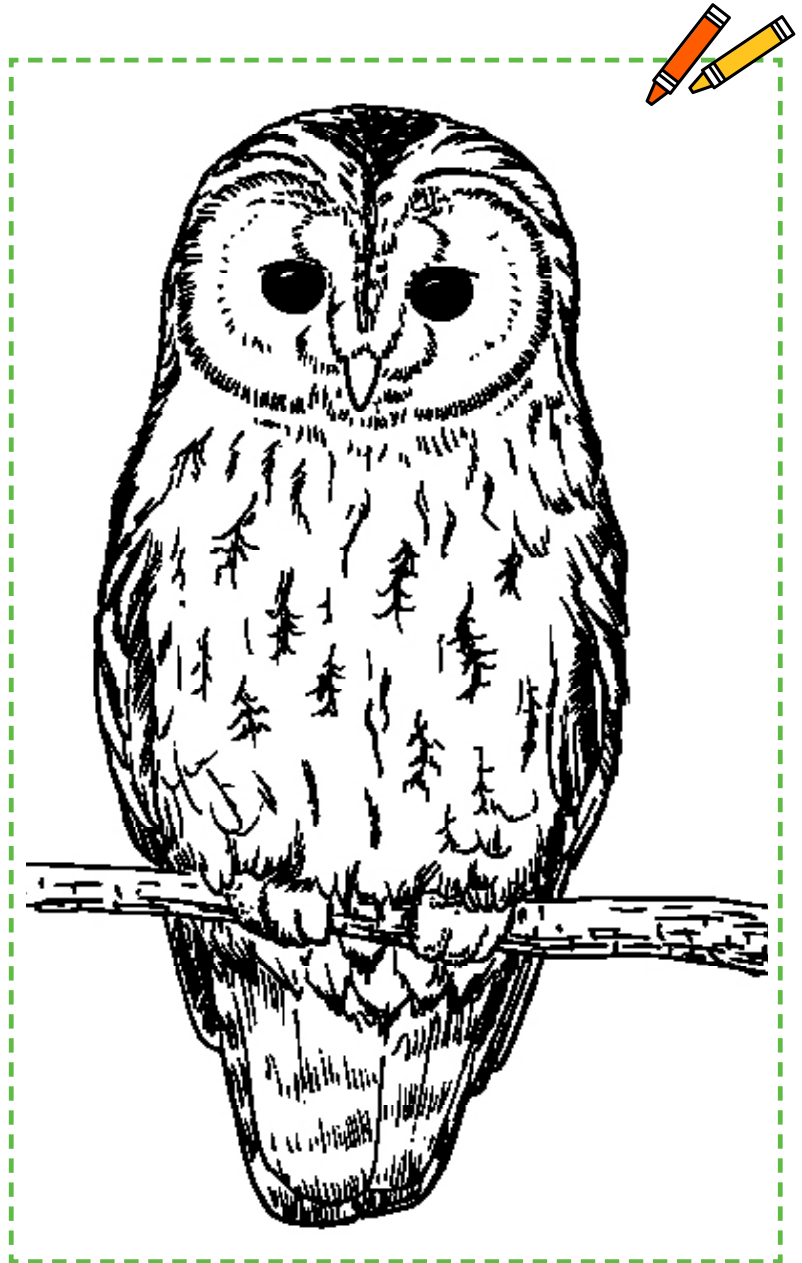
