- ▶ Arctic terns migrate over 40,000 kilometres from their Arctic breeding grounds to Antarctica.

- ▶ Look out for aquatic birds that appear to have only one leg! Wading birds will stand on one leg while holding the other one close to their warm body to conserve heat.



- ▶ There are more than 400 migratory bird species in Canada.

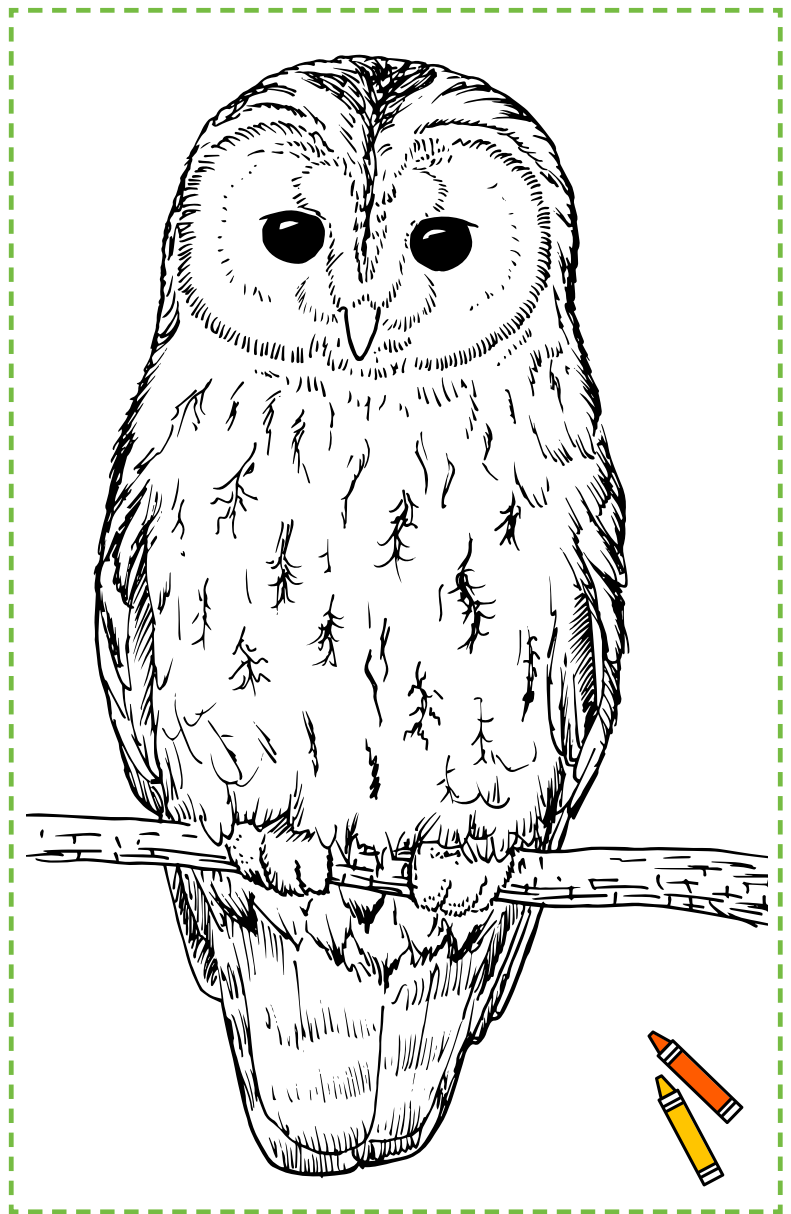
